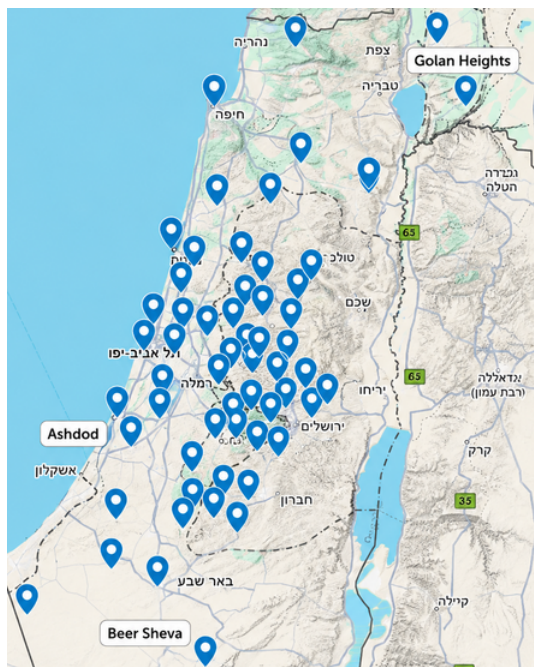

DRIVEN BY MISSION: RESILIENCE UNDER FIRE (OPERATION ROARING LION)

When the "Roaring Lion" operation began, the true spirit of our school was revealed through the selfless actions of our students. While the hospital executed a rapid transition to underground facilities in under 48 hours, it was our nursing students who stood at the forefront of this effort as dedicated volunteers. Despite the personal danger and uncertainty, 74 of our students immediately stepped forward to volunteer. We were profoundly moved by their commitment; many of our religious students left their homes and families on Shabbat, driving under fire to ensure they could serve where they were needed most.

These student volunteers were instrumental in:



Providing essential clinical support

including assisting in departments, managing medical equipment, and comforting the families of the hospitalized.



Preparing hospital bunkers

and converting the underground parking lot into a sheltered clinical ward.



Ensuring operational continuity

by assisting with patient intake and medical logistics in "bunker" conditions.



Physically transferring patients

from hospital departments to secure underground facilities to ensure their safety.

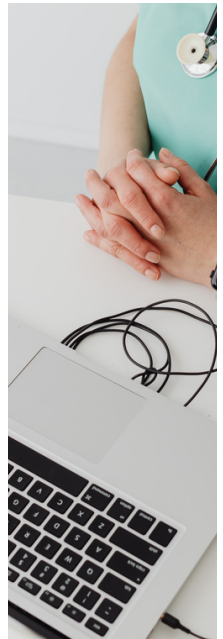


US BUILDING GLOBAL BRIDGES: ELITE COLLABORATION WITH COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY
